

MANITOBA SUMMER GAMES POWERED BY MANITOBA HYDRO Dauphin 2024

Volleyball Manitoba is now accepting applications for 2024 Manitoba Games Powered by Manitoba Hydro Girls & Boys Regional Team Coaching and Manager Positions August 11-17, 2024

Staged every two years and alternating between summer and winter sporting events, the Manitoba Games powered by Manitoba Hydro is the largest ongoing multi-sport event in the province. Every two years, the Games are awarded to a Host Community that comes together to put on this multi-sport event. The Games create important legacies in new and enhanced sport facilities, volunteer and leadership development that build capacity and support for amateur sport across the province.

Volleyball Manitoba is proud to work with Sport Manitoba and the Dauphin host society and be a part of the Manitoba Games in the summer of 2024. The age category for volleyball is 14U (born in 2010 or later). The 2024 Manitoba Games will involve 8 teams per gender from the regions of Winnipeg (2 Teams) North (1 Team), East (1 Team), West (2 Teams) & South (2 Teams).

Each regional team has up to 3 staff positions available.

- Head Coach
- Assistant Coach
- Team Manager.

NOTE: At least one of the staff positions on each team must be filled by a person of the same gender as the athletes.

Head Coach and Assistant Coach

Working alongside Volleyball Manitoba, the Head and Assistant Coach will play a lead role in team selection, player development and general preparation leading up to, and including the Manitoba Games. Ideally, the coach will reside in the region where they are applying to coach.

Duties and expectations will include but not be limited to:

- Games promotion This will involve promoting the Manitoba Games program and providing information to athletes and families in your region.
- Work with Volleyball Manitoba on the planning and execution of athlete selection camp and player selection.
- Work with Volleyball Manitoba on the planning and execution of summer training plan for 2024.
- Preparation of your team for competition at the Manitoba Games
- Stay in the athletes village and supervise your team for the duration of the Games. Ensure all team members adhere to: Manitoba Games village rules, Manitoba Games Code of Conduct, etc..
- Post program evaluation

Team Manager

The Team Manager works with Volleyball Manitoba, Manitoba Games, Dauphin Host Society other games partners to support the coaching staff with planning, logistics and communication prior to and while and at Games

Duties and expectations will include but not be limited to:

- Serve as the key communication link between Volleyball Manitoba, Manitoba Games, and coaching staff
- Distribute and collect necessary information from athletes and coaches regarding registration, schedules, practices, uniforms, accreditation, transportation, host society updates, etc.
- Ensure that all team members, including coaches, adhere to the Manitoba Games village rules, Manitoba Games Code of Conduct..
- Work with Volleyball Manitoba, Manitoba Games and Host Society to manage team operations and logistics during the games including accreditation, accommodation, food, transportation, medal and opening/closing ceremonies, team down-time, arrival/departure, village check in/out, etc.

Successful candidates must meet the following requirements:

- All team staff must have completed the requirements consistent with the Volleyball Manitoba Screening policy within 30 days of being appointed to their respective role and prior to participating in any Team Manitoba activities.
 - o Screening Requirements
- **Head Coaches** must meet the appropriate eligibility **and** year 1 and 2 technical requirements for coaches at the 14U level attending a Provincial or National Championship **or** hold Development Coach Certification. Eligibility and technical requirements must be completed by April 30, 2024.
 - o Head Coach Eligibility and Technical Requirements
- All team staff must be over the age of 18 by May 31, 2024
- All team staff must complete any additional screening/training as required by the Manitoba Games not already mentioned above.
