Teams are required to abide by the Volleyball Canada Uniform Guidelines, and are encouraged to use the VC Uniform Approval Request Form

- Teams must follow VC Uniform Guidelines (approval form available).
- VM follows the VC Rule Book, with exceptions outlined here.

Roster Size:

- 15U-18U: up to 14 players may be listed and play.
- 13U-14U: maximum of 12 players on the game sheet.

Substitution Rules

VM 15U - 18U (Unlimited Substitutions - Trial Rule)

- 12 substitutions allowed, unlimited in/out.
- Starter can re-enter only their original position.
- Substitutes can only replace the same starter.
- Goal: increase playing opportunities.

13U-14U (Fair Play)

- Minimum 9 players must be on the score sheet.
- Players may play in max 2 of 3 sets.
- No substitutions in sets 1 & 2 (except for injury).
- 3rd set allows 12 unlimited substitutions for eligible players.
- Exemptions must be requested from VM if fewer than 9 players are available (not permitted at Provincials).

Exceptional Substitutions (NEW):

- Allowed for athletes in significant emotional or mental distress after all time-outs used.
- Athlete removed cannot return that set but may play later.



Serving Space Rule:

- Courts with less than 3m serving space: one step on the end line allowed.
- Stepping into the court = fault.
- If only one side has <3m, rule applies to that side only.

Curtain Rule:

- Players may not push curtains to create serving space or prevent a ball hitting the curtain.
- Contacting the curtain after a legal play = no fault.
- Violations: ball called "out," point to opponent.
