

2024 Manitoba Summer Games FAQ

Q: When is the volleyball competition at the games?

A: Volleyball is in phase 1 of the games from August 11-14 2024

Q: How old do you have to be to play?

A: Athletes must be born in 2010 or later to be eligible to participate in the games.

Q: When are tryouts?

A: May-June 2024. The dates will vary depending on the region.

Q: Where are tryouts?

A: Tryouts will take place in their respective regions. The specific dates, times and locations will be announced on the Volleyball Manitoba website once all details are in place. (May-June 2024)

Q: Will there be a cost to try out?

A: Yes, \$25 per player

Q: How many teams are there at the games?

A: There are 8 regional teams per gender. South - 2 teams, East 1 Team, West - (2 teams), North (1 Team) and Winnipeg - 2 teams.

Q: Do I have to try out for the team in the region in which I live?

A: Yes, you must try out for the team in the region that you live in.

Q: Where will the team train in my region?

A: The primary training location will depend on the community where the coaches and players live as well as facility availability in the region. We will try to find central training locations in larger regions.

Q: What is the cost to play on a Manitoba Summer Games volleyball team?

A: The final amount is TBC. There will be a fee payable to Sport Manitoba for the games as well as a fee payable to Volleyball Manitoba for the training and preparation leading up to the games.

Q: What is included in the cost?

A: The games fee will include all training sessions leading up to the games, uniforms and training shirts, transportation to the games, accommodations at the games in the athletes village, meals while at the games.

Q: What is the time commitment to play on a team?

A: Athletes can expect to train 1-3 times a week beginning in June and running until the games. Days and times TBC based on coach and facility availability.
