



2027 Volleyball Manitoba Age Categories

Volleyball Manitoba follows Volleyball Canada's age categories for competitions:

- Age groups run **13U–18U**, based on birth month, not just birth year.
- Volleyball Manitoba uses a 16-month eligibility window, giving athletes flexibility to play at the most appropriate level.
- **Volleyball Manitoba is stricter than Volleyball Canada:**
 - Only athletes within the 16-month window can play 18U.
 - No athletes involved in USport/CCAA/post-secondary volleyball during Sept 2025–May 2026 can be on 18U rosters.
- Exemptions are rare and only approved under extraordinary circumstances.
- All exemption requests must go through Volleyball Manitoba first.

Age Categories Chart

Note: Age categories are listed as **13U–18U** (not U13–U18). Please use this format consistently, especially during online registration.

Guiding Principles

- **Long-Term Development (LTD):** The 16-month age window helps athletes compete at the right level for their development instead of being restricted by birth year.
- Athletes, parents, and coaches should weigh both short-term and long-term benefits when choosing an age category.
- Clubs may set their own policies for "playing up" or "playing down."

18U Exceptions (Volleyball Canada vs. Volleyball Manitoba)

- **VC Policy:** Allows two athletes born Jan 1 – Aug 31, 2007 to play 18U.
 - **VM Policy:** Not allowed. Only athletes in the 16-month window may participate.
- **VC Policy:** Allows two current USport, CCAA, or other post-secondary athletes born Sept 1 – Dec 31, 2007 to play 18U.
 - **VM Policy:** Not allowed.
- **VM Roster Rule:** Athletes may not participate on VM rosters if they are part of any USport, CCAA, or other post-secondary volleyball program during Sept 2025 – May 2026.

Definition of Post-Secondary Participation:

- Training with a post-secondary volleyball program (in whole or part) starting Oct 1, 2025.
- Athletes may try out/train with a post-secondary team in September 2025.
- Applies to all athletes (including redshirts).
- Does not apply to intramural or recreational club programs.
- Head Coaches must confirm verification.

Overage Exemptions

- Goal: To provide athletes an opportunity to participate in club volleyball while creating a fair and safe environment for all involved.
- Exemptions:
 - Under extraordinary circumstances only, an exemption request for athletes born prior to the 16-month window to play in a specific age group may be considered. The Head Coach/Team Manager must make a request. Initial requests must go to Volleyball Manitoba. If granted and a team is



planning on attending Nationals, acknowledgement of Volleyball Manitoba's decision must be provided in the submission to Volleyball Canada.
